Geographically, Germany lies approximately at the same latitude as southern Canada. Summer days in Germany are longer than in the United States, winter days are shorter. In winter, the average daily temperature is between 35°F in central and northern Germany and 21°F in southern Germany. In July, the warmest month of the year, average temperatures in these regions vary between 64° and 68°F. Exceptions are the Upper Rhine Valley in the southwest with its extremely mild climate, Bavaria with its warm alpine wind (*Föhn*) from the south, and the Harz Mountains, a climate zone of its own with cold winds, cool summers and heavy snow in winter.
